

2020 CYBA Youth Basketball Tournament Rules

- Equipment:** 28.5" basketball
- Clock:** 18 minute running time; stops on timeouts and during the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half and overtime if the point differential is 10 points or less.
- 7th Grade Girls:** All presses and defenses are allowed. No pressing by the leading team is allowed if the point differential is 20 points or greater.
- Man to Man Pressing Only:** **3rd & 4th Grade:** Only allowed during the last **2 minutes** of the game. A full court man to man press is allowed in the final 2 minutes of the game if the score is within 20 points.
- 5th & 6th Grade:** Only allowed during the last **5 minutes** of the game. A full court man to man press is allowed in the final 5 minutes of the game if the score is within 20 points.
- Zone Defenses:** A defensive player is allowed to play help defense only once an offensive player has passed by his/her defender. Once the offensive player's momentum to the basket has been stopped and the defender has recovered, the help defender must recover to another offensive player that is uncovered. The first infraction will be a warning and the following infraction/s will incur two free throws and the basketball to the offensive team.
- Free Throws:** Bonus awarded on the 7th team foul of the half, double bonus on the 10th team foul of the half.
3rd/4th Grade-Players can jump over the line
All Other Grades-Normal free throw rules apply
- Timeouts:** 2 timeouts per game
- Overtime:** 1 minute period for the first overtime; sudden death occurs after 1 overtime period. Timeouts carry over from regulation.
