

2022 CYBA Youth Basketball Tournament Rules

Equipment:	28.5" basketball
Clock:	18-minute running time; stops on timeouts and during the last 2 minutes of the 2 nd half and overtime if the point differential is 10 points or less.
5th, 6th, 7th Grade Boys & Girls Red (A) Divisions Only	All full court presses and defenses are allowed. No full court pressing by either team is allowed if the point differential is 20 points or greater.
Defensive Rules for all White (B) Divisions and 3rd - 4th Grade	Full Court Pressing only allowed during the last 2 minutes of the game. A full court man to man press is allowed in the final 2 minutes of the game if the score is within 20 points.
Fouls	A player will be disqualified from the game after a combination of 5 personal and/or technical fouls. 2 free throws and possession awarded to opposing team after a technical foul. Any player or coach receiving a 2 nd technical will be disqualified from the current game. Coaches will need to remain seated after the first technical and leave the gym after the 2 nd technical.
Free Throws:	Bonus awarded on the 7 th team foul of the half, double bonus on the 10 th team foul of the half. 3 rd /4 th Grade-Players can jump over the line. 3 rd Grade Girls can move up to 12 feet. Line will be marked with tape. All Other Grades-Normal free throw rules apply
Timeouts:	2 timeouts per game (no carry over to overtime)
Overtime:	2-minute period for the first overtime; sudden death occurs after 1 overtime period. 1 Timeout in the First overtime period only.
NDHSAA	All NDHSAA rules apply where not specified above.
